Ms. Rawl. C. 564 measures 180 x 120 mm. It has no trace of its earlier history except that 'Frater Joachimus' is written in red ink on fol. 1 in a hand contemporary with the text.

The volume was bequeathed to the Bodleian by Richard Rawlinson in 1756 and bears his bookplate.

I do not understand your question whether this Ms. is autograph. I think it is better in corresponding about manuscripts for each party to write in his own language.

Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter to Dr. Hunt, who is now away on holiday. The list of Dionysius Carthusiensis' works deposited at Bruges in 1461 found in MS. Rawl. C. 564, cannot be autograph but must be a copy, for the note on fol. 5^v of the manuscript, quoted in full in the Rawlinson Catalogue and recording Dyonisius' death in 1471, is written by the same scribe as the list of works, and apparently at the same time. There is a further possible indication of provenance, not noted by Dr. Hunt. On fol. 2, at the top and very faint, in a 16th cent. (?) hand is the note 'Cartusie Lovan³'.
